

## GDA Scholarship Application Instructions 2011-2012

### Student Criteria:

- Students must be enrolled in a full-time undergraduate dietetics or diet technician program with plans to continue academic studies or an internship the following year.
- Participation in the American Dietetic Association is encouraged, along with state and district organizations such as the Genesee Dietetic Association (GDA).
- Preference will be given to those applicants who have not previously been awarded a GDA scholarship.

### Completion of Application:

- Responses may be handwritten in the spaces provided or typed on a separate sheet of paper.
- Applications submitted via email will not be accepted. Do not send a résumé.
- Two (2) signed letters of recommendation – One (1) must be from your academic advisor. One (1) may be from an instructor, a Registered Dietitian (RD), or Registered Diet Technician (DTR).
- Letters of recommendation must be sealed in an envelope with the writer's signature over the seal. These envelopes must be given to you to submit with your completed scholarship application.
- Return completed scholarship application along with the two (2) letters of recommendation via first class mail to:

- All applications will be reviewed during March 2012 and award winners will be notified by April 15, 2012.
